Here is everything to date that you need to know about Reconciliation and First Communion. **Mandatory Parent Meeting: When? November 19, 2009 Where? In Church What Time? 7:00pm - 8:00pm**

This meeting will cover the roles of parents in the preparation of children for these two sacraments and the practical ways this preparation will take in the days to come. All families must be represented. Thank you!

Celebration of Reconciliation

In order to afford time for this all important sacrament as well as give parents the opportunity to receive the sacrament as the best example for children, the following times have been set up for the Sacrament of Reconciliation:

Monday: March 1, 2009: Day School grades 2A and 2 B

Monday: March 8, 2009: PSR Grade 2A and $\frac{1}{2}$ of PSR 2C class

Monday: March 15, 2009: PSR Grade 2B and $\frac{1}{2}$ of PSR 2C class

With more time available, we will be able to help those out who might be sick on their assigned day.

Practice for First Communion (ONLY PRACTICE!)

(Jesus Day has been moved to AFTER the reception of First Communion) **First Communion is now on MAY 1, 2010**

Students assigned to the 9:30am Mass (both 2A classes-Day School & PSR and $\frac{1}{2}$ of PSR 2C) will practice on April 30, 2010 in Church from 5:00 pm-6:00pm.

Students assigned to the 12:00 noon Mass (Both 2B classes- Day School & PSR and $\frac{1}{2}$ of PSR 2C) will practice from 6:00pm- 7:00pm in Church.

First Communion: May 1, 2010 (This date was changed because a wedding had already been scheduled on the books and could not be moved.)

Jesus Day is scheduled for May 8, 2010 from 9:00am - 2:00pm in the gym. This special day is celebrated after all have received Jesus. Yes! All are expected to attend. More information on this day will follow.
