Minutes of:

Regular Meeting, June 13, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jo Ann Tomasheski, at 10:10 am with a prayer said by Fr. Bob.

In attendance were: Jo Ann Tomasheski, Jackie Madisen, Fr. Bob and Vince Farrell.

Jo Ann gave us a wrap-up on Pentecost Sunday. We bought 2 boxes of cookies, enough to make 240 cookies. What was left was given to Jerry Tomasheski for his nursing home visits and the balance to the home visit people for their people.

Also purchased were baggies, cost \$7.00; a helium tank and balloons. What helium was left over will be given to VBS.

Jo Ann said that she was not speaking on behalf of the committee but rather as a member of St. Peter Parish. She was not happy that the Holy Name also was in Apostle Hall at the same time. She intends to write a letter to the Parish Council stating "that if they expect commissions, organizations and ministries to man donut

Sunday under the guise of promoting their organization, no other organization should be allowed to promote themselves at that time."

Jo Ann went on to give us a wrap up of the Summer Blessing held on June 5th.

We purchased 4 buckets of ice cream at a cost of \$20/00. we ran short and Fr. Bob brought some of his special stock from the rectory. Jo Ann suggested that we purchase an addition bucket next year. We also purchased sprinkles, bowls and whipping cream for a cost of 25.00. We had carmel, chocolate and raspberry toppings from last year, all of which we used up.

Sean Reitz, a parishioner, donated several cans and containers of toppings of which we only used a little. He said that what we didn't use could go to some other parish function. Decision was made to donate to VBS.

We had enough punch to make two batches but only used one, again the left over one will be donated to VBS. The monies spent above came from the cash \$118.00 we kept aside from the Women's luncheon.

We had 85 St. Christopher medals left from last year and now have 7 left. We will purchase more for next year's event.

Vince advise us that he counted between 85 to 90 persons in attendance.

The door prize, donated by Fr. Bob seemed to be a big hit and was discussed that perhaps we should have some next year.

Father Bob advised us that someone suggested that next year we hold a "cruise in" asking parishioners to bring in their old and special cars. No decision was made and we will explore this possibility in the future.

Since we did not have a quorum on hand, no formal election was held. However, those in agreement suggested the following slate of officers for the upcoming year.

For Chairman, Maggie Finney, For- vice Chairman, Jackie Madisen and for Secretary, Vince Farrell.

Our next meeting will be held on September 12, 2015.
